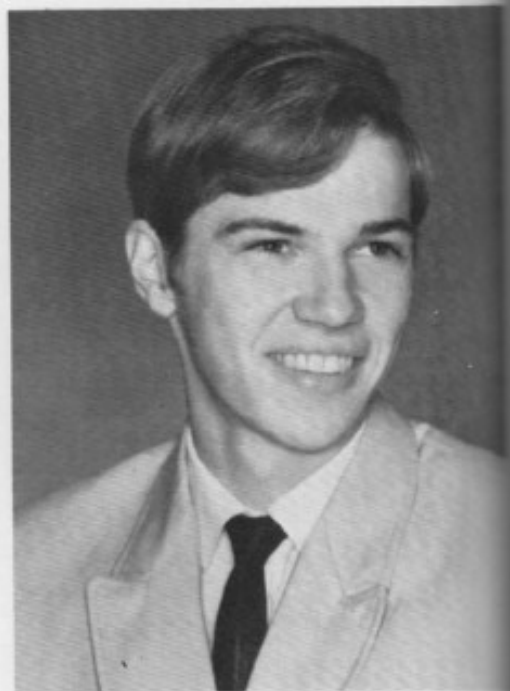


TERRY ADAMS

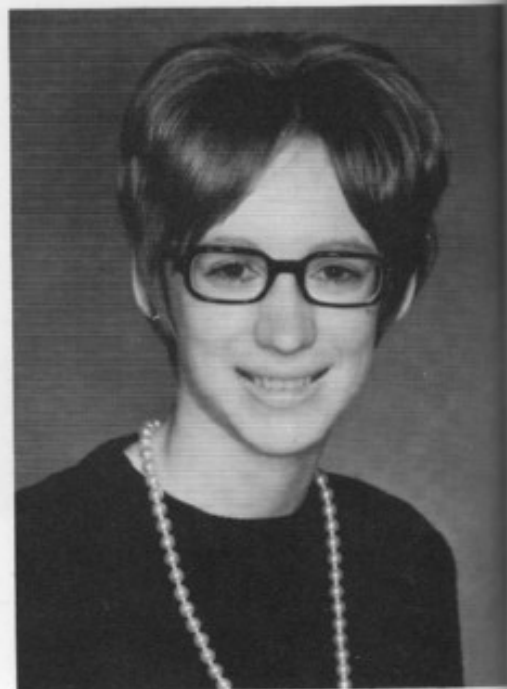
CARL ALLEN

"Bet" plans on college in the fall. Selling refreshments seems to be her favorite hobby. She loves Home Ec. and frequently says, "Leave me alone."

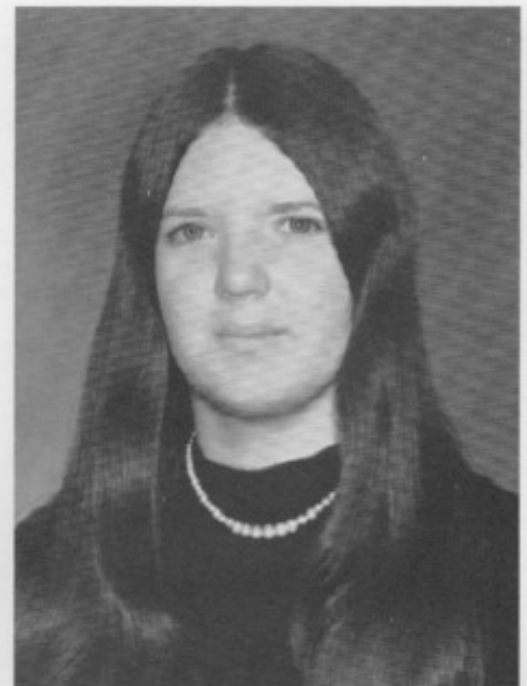


LUCINDA A. ARMOUR

"Elsie" likes Art and sports and Mike. She wants to be either in the fashion world or a doctor's assistant. She can be found waiting at locker #18 after first period.

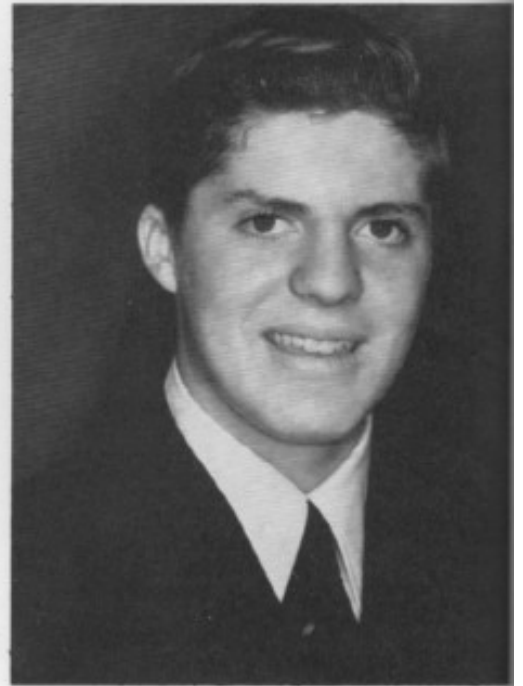


JOHN M. BERGER

"Berg's" favorite sports are wrestling, football and girls. He's lucky in cars and plans on Marine Air Corps.



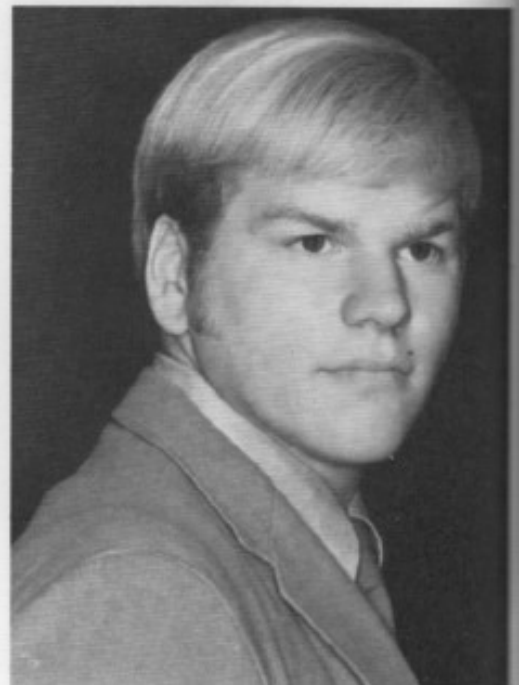
BETTY ANN BROWNELL

unfortunately sometimes confuses them.



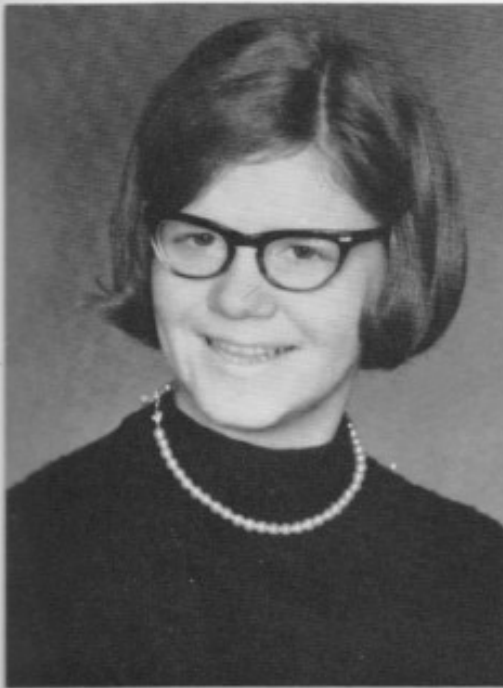
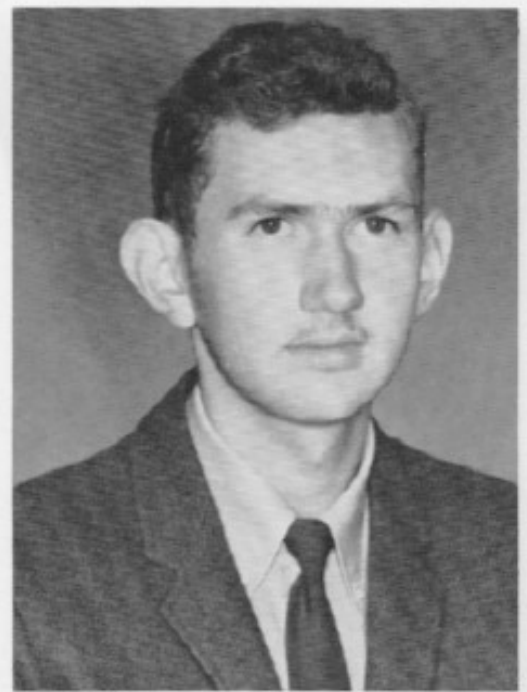
SUE CARD

The shy guy with the news. Likes Ag. Business and Bowling, and is the one man traveling sales team for the Senior class.

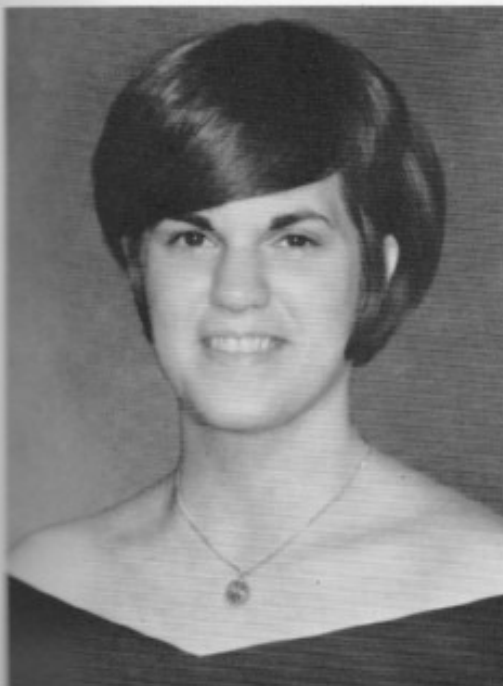
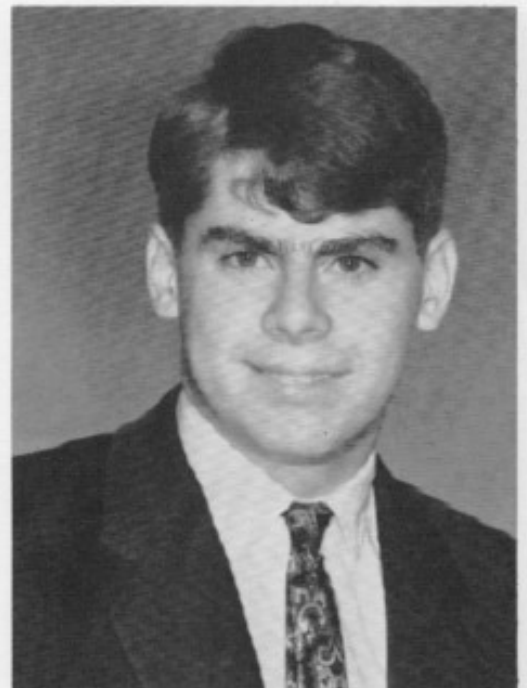


JEANETTE V. CHURCH

"Albert" is the hunter of our class. He likes math and wrestling and he plans on joining the Air Force.



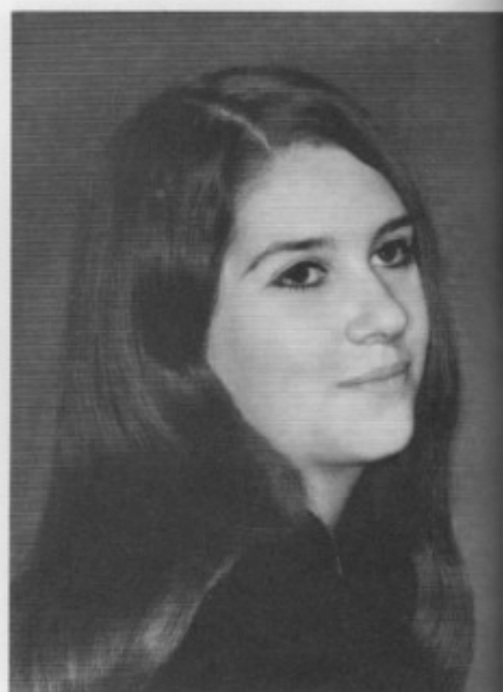
LAURIE CRANDALL

"Crandall" is our class comedienne. She likes art and motorcycles.



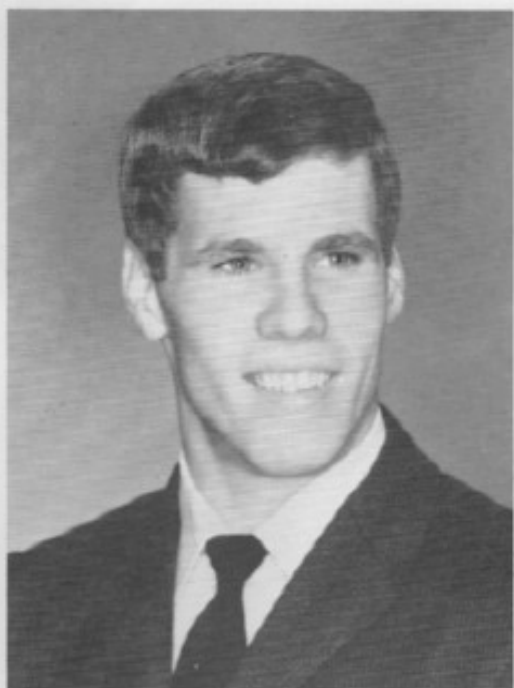
PAMELA RUTH DOUGLAS

"Pam" likes sports, and Dave. She's making plans for a future with X-Ray Technology. You'll always find her on the hill.



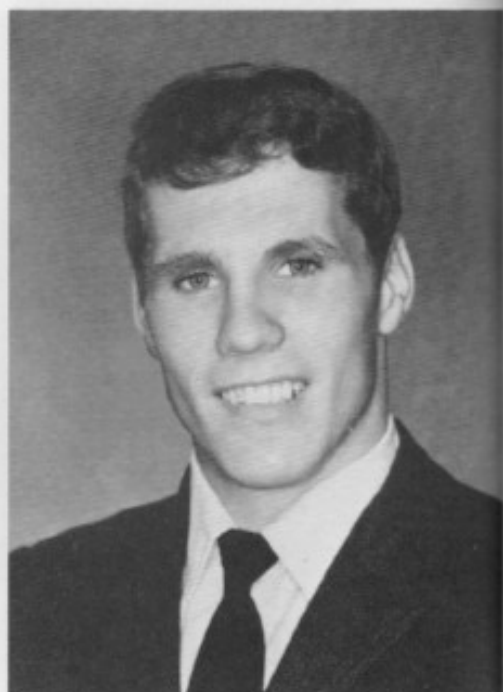
CONNIE JEAN DUNHAM

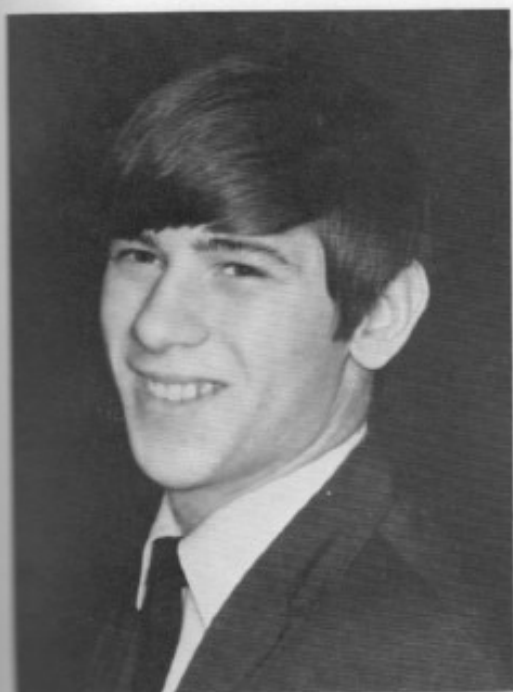
JULIE DIANE DYE

"Ecky" twice has made the county all star football team and he has a trophy to prove it. He has been class president for most of his high school career. He will either go to college or join the service.



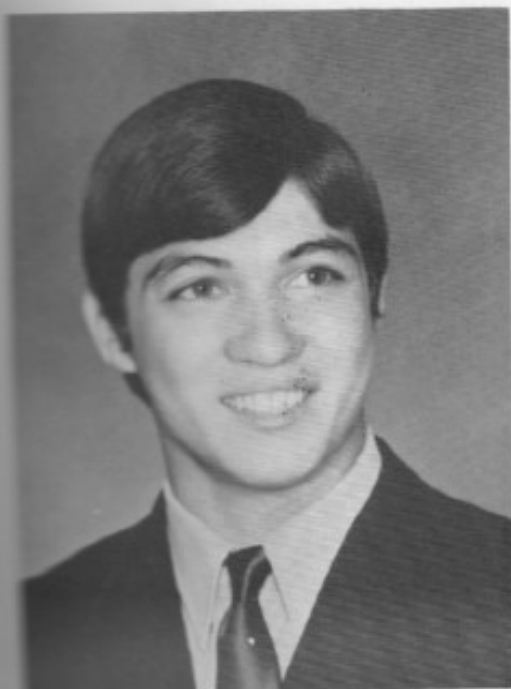
ROY FAIRCHILD

JACK FITZGERALD

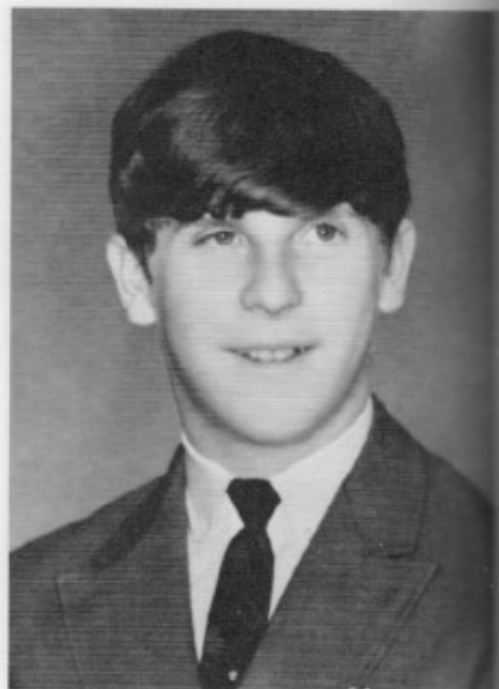

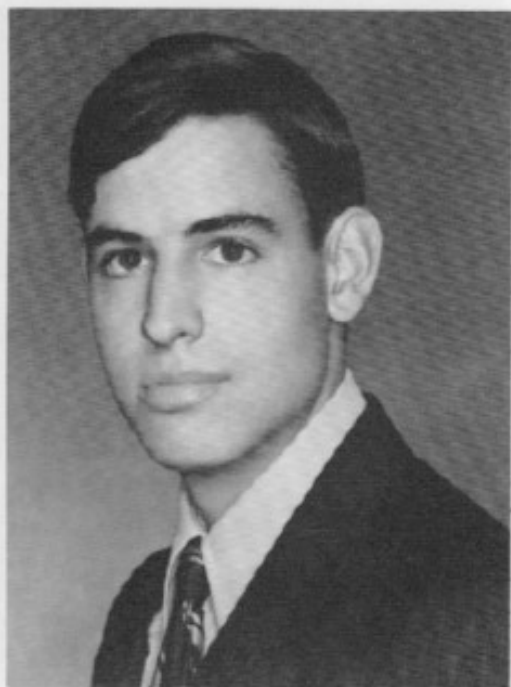
VALERIE J. GREGORY

Val is known for dinner table discussions. She likes motorcycles and M. G.'s and will marry Bob or become a nun.



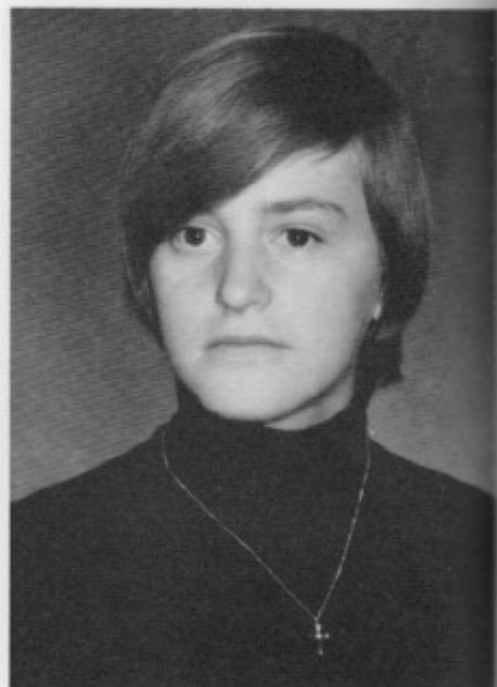
MICHAEL HOXIE

Wild Bill Hic-cup is the super star of the local F. F. A. He wants to be a pilot and flies on weekends to keep in practice.

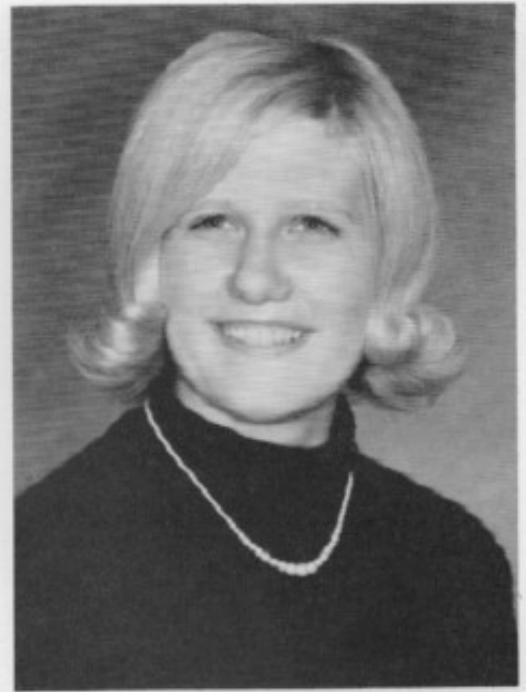


SUSAN MAXSON

Joanie is happy and smiling in spite of Psychology and working in the nursing home.

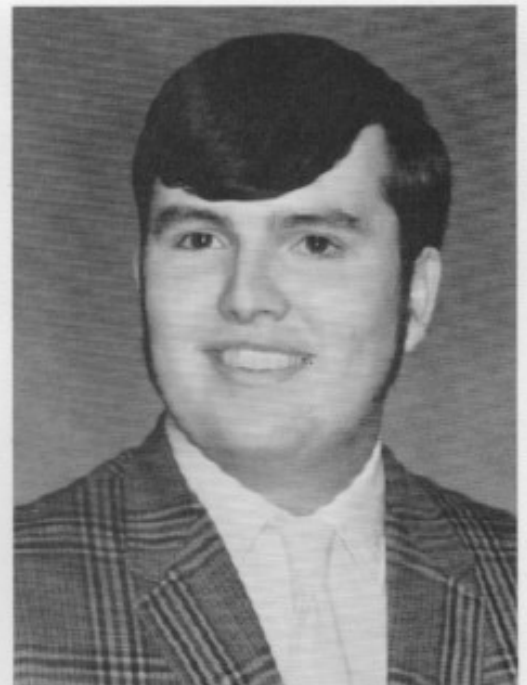


ILONA BRIGGITTE NAUBEREIT

CAROL L. POINTON

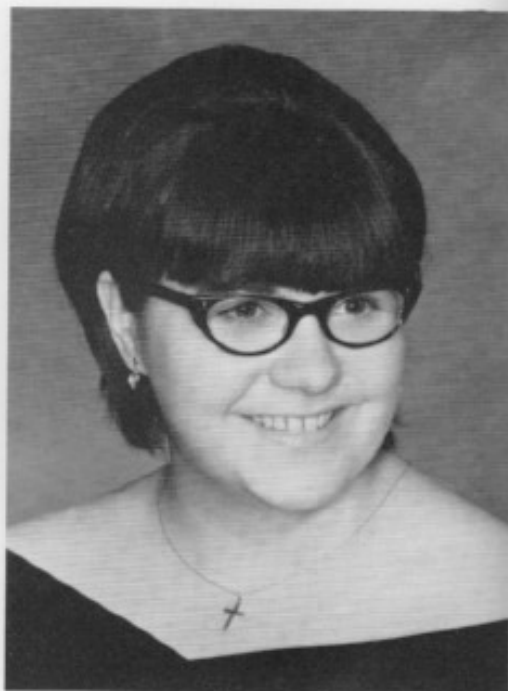
With Carol, it is often the principal of the thing that counts. She plans to go to college and become an elementary teacher in another district.





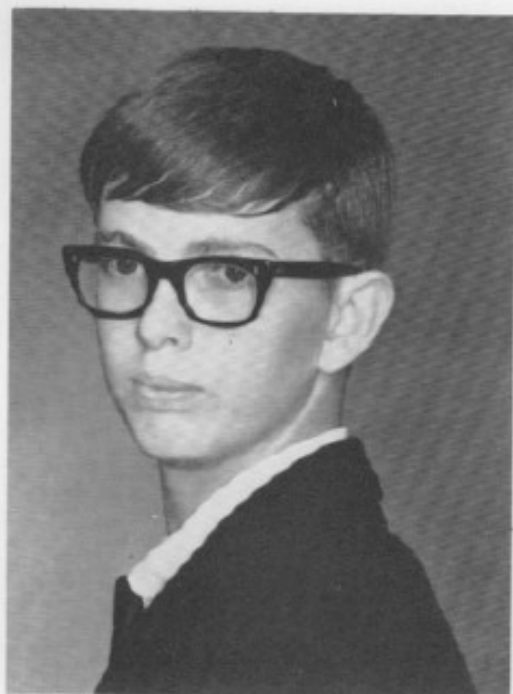
ROBERT REID

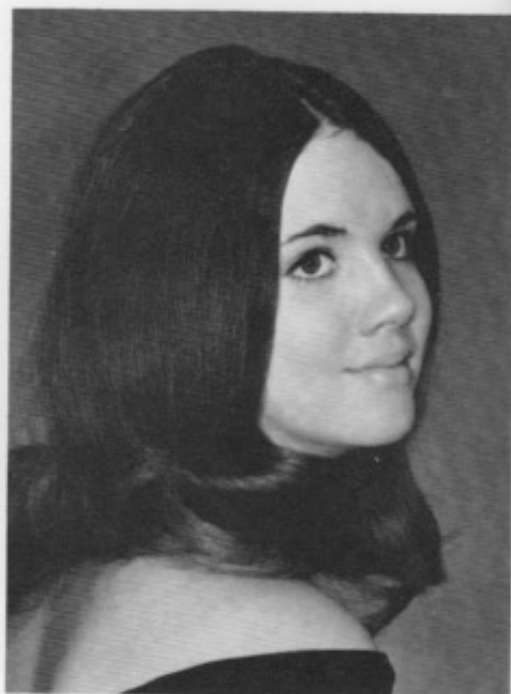
GLORIA JEAN ROE

Vicki likes snowmobiling, math and is interested in secretarial school. Her unique laughter can be often heard from the guidance office to the locker room.

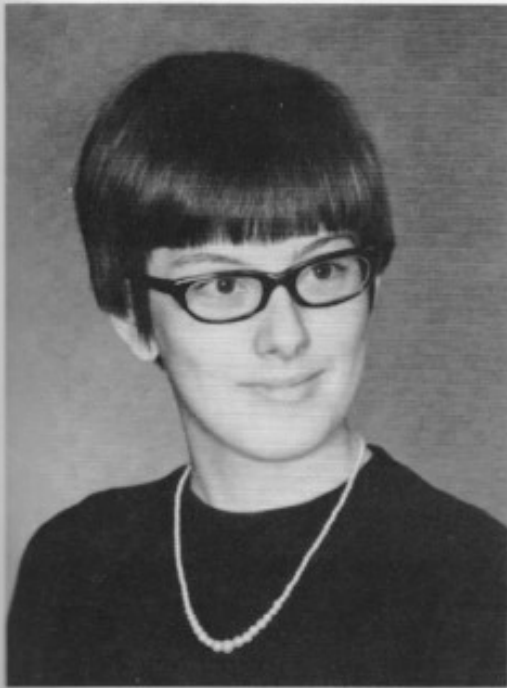
SARA L. SEIBERT

Sandy is lively. Likes English and plans to go to college. She is in Library Club and F.H.A. and says "ol Fudge" to dumb kids.



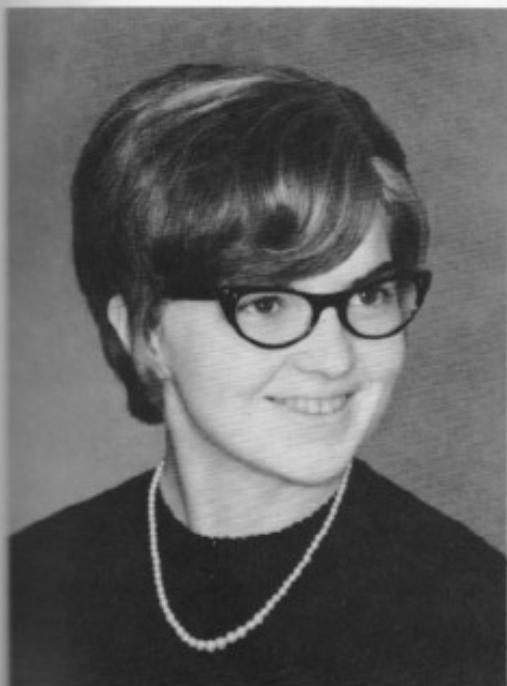

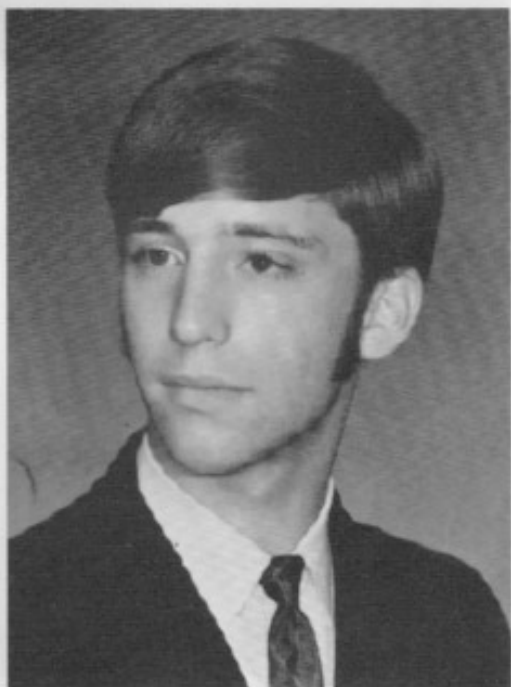
Jeanne, or Carrots wants to go to Med School and is good at being bad at athletics.



SHIRLEY R. SWEET

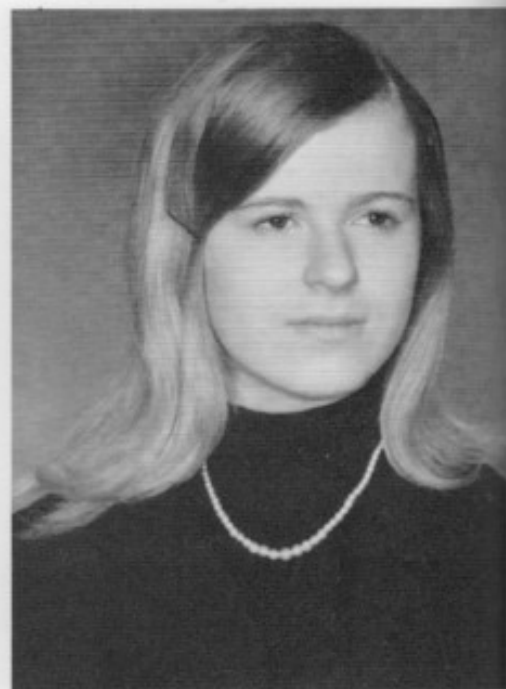
"Sweet Pea" is shy and yet manages to make a deal of trouble. "You Pollock" can often be heard in the Home Ec. room when Sweetie is there.

Mike is like greased lightening on the track team. He likes to "fool around" and is going to Ryder Tech in the fall.



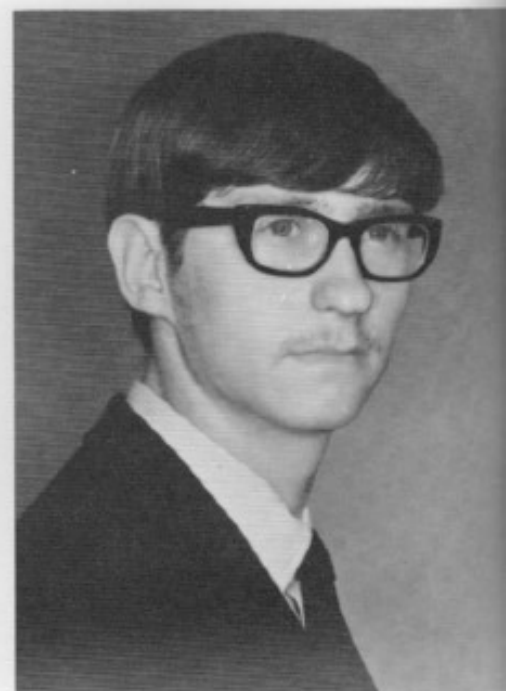
BRENDA TOOLEY

"Sport's" favorite activity is party-hopping. She works hard to get out of work, yet her "actions speak louder than words."



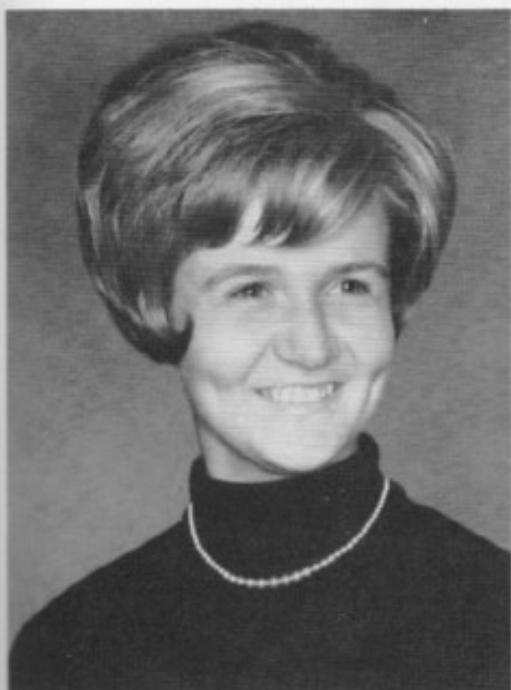
GARY L. WAFFLE
